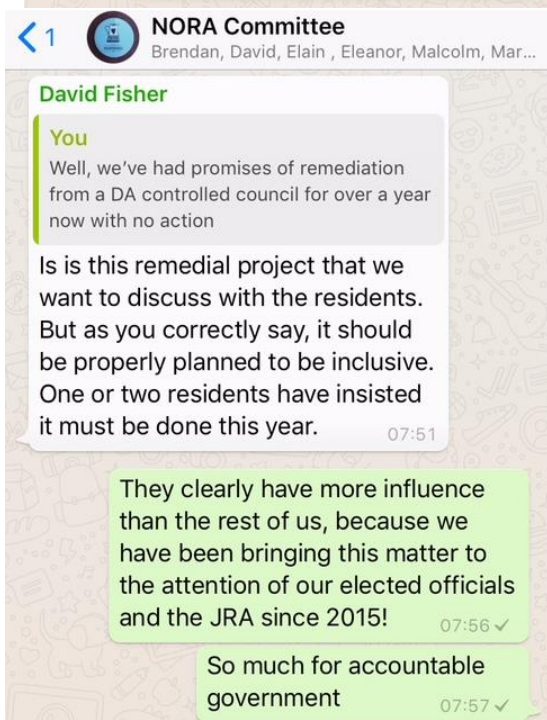

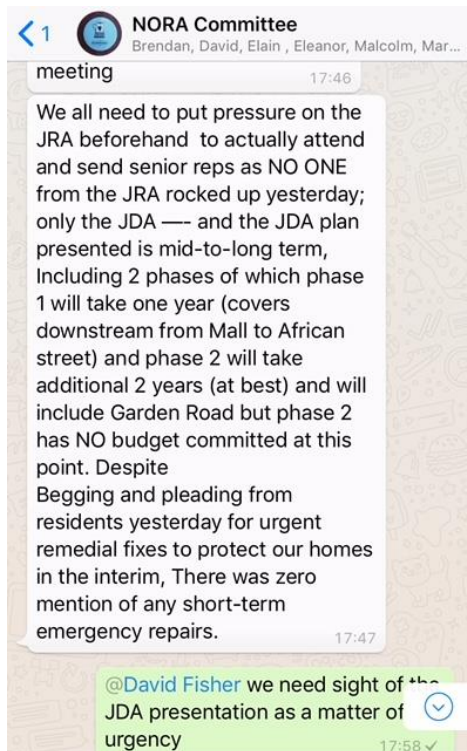

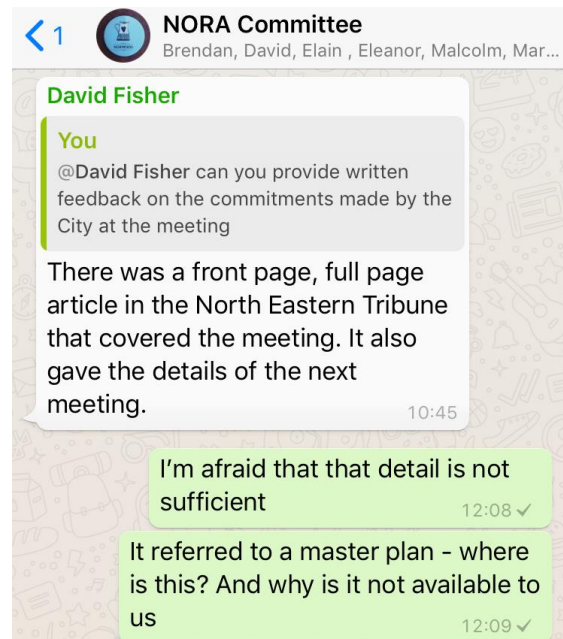
2. Frustration at poor notice for public meeting on flooding issues
